Registration Requirements

On line registration: <https://bit.ly/KDCTAEventRegistration>

1. Competitors must Pre-enter classes ONLINE @ www.striderpro.com
2. Then search for KDCTA shows OR find direct link on our website www.kdcta.org OR use the bit.ly link above.
3. Copy of coggins, signed EWaiver for all riders are required. Any required documents can be uploaded to your Strider account, then can be attached to the show you wish to attend.
4. STRIDER's open-access entry platform supports guest checkout and payment with any credit card, VENMO or paypal through a secure payment gateway. You can even upload coggins and when completing entries as a guest.
5. NOTE: Your credit card statement will show entry fees and STRIDER handling fee as separate charges.
6. ***To save time as a frequent STRIDER user, you can create a FREE member account. Benefits include:
 - Cloud-based document storage (save your coggins, equine vaccine records, and more)
 - Convenient horse & rider profiles for expedited entries (add multiple horses/ riders in one member dashboard)

7. Dressage rides are limited unless enough entries warrant a second judge. All Dressage Rides must be pre-paid. Dressage ride times assigned only upon receipt of payment & forms.
8. COGGINS: A copy of a negative Coggins taken within 12 months of the show date is required for each horse entered. If no proof of Coggins, you will be asked to leave the show grounds.
9. Entries not postmarked by the closing date will have a late fee of \$30 per horse/rider.
10. Scratches after the closing date are non-refundable. If verified by a veterinarian, a \$35 office fee will apply.
11. **CLOSING DATE:** Saturday September 19, 2026 at 12am.
12. *****All competitors need to check out before leaving*****

General Rules

1. Registration Booth opens at 8:00AM. All Rings start at 9:00 AM unless otherwise stated.
2. The decisions of the judges and show secretary/manager are final. USEF/USDF rules will be followed.
3. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine, add or divide classes if conditions warrant.
4. AGE: As of January 1st Jr Riders = 18 years & under, Sr. Riders = 19 years and up.
5. DRESS: Dress will be casual, but suitable boots and an ASTM certified helmet are required for every rider while mounted anywhere on show grounds. Dressage or Western attire is encouraged but not required. Paddock boots and half chaps are allowed. Full chaps are not acceptable in English Dressage classes.
6. ALL DOGS must be leashed at all times.
7. STALLIONS: Must be well mannered.

Stabling and Parking

1. ARRIVAL: No arrivals before 4pm on Friday. Any horses arriving on Friday cannot be ridden or worked anywhere on the grounds. Hand walking on the roadway is permissible. Use of any rings or arenas on Friday is strictly prohibited. Only use stalls assigned to competitor. Use of additional stalls and shavings must be approved by show management.
2. STABLING: Stalls & Shavings must be requested on pre-registration entry form. No straw bedding allowed. Stalls do not need to be cleaned prior to departure. No nails or staples or fans are allowed. No cooking or sleeping in the barns is allowed. Additional shavings must be requested from the show manager or stall manager. Please include stabling requests in notes to organizer when registering.
3. PARKING: Trailer parking only in designated areas. No trailers next to barn except for unloading/loading. No parking any trailers on the grass.
1. CAMPING/RV's: Must provide vehicle and license plate info upon arrival. \$50 per night. Includes electric and water hook-ups and one free dump at the Dump Station. 30- and 50-amp service is available.

2. GROUNDS FEE: per horse/rider combo on the grounds.

BE SURE TO SELECT THE APPROPRIATE GROUNDS FEE WHEN REGISTERING.

3. FEES:

Dressage: \$40 per test

Freestyle: \$40 per test (please have one person sign-up and pay for MFS in the case of multiple riders)

Post Entry Fee: \$30 /horse-rider for entries submitted after the closing date.

Scratch Fee: Refund only considered with proof of Veterinary Certificate. \$30 office fee applies.

Stall Fees: \$45 per day for horse/tack stall.

One stall on: Sat only=\$45, Fri/Sat=\$90, Sat/Sun=\$90, Fri-Sun=\$135

Shavings: \$8.50 per bale of shavings

4. CAMPING/RV's: \$50 per night. Includes electric and water hook-ups and one free dump at the Dump Station. 30- and 50-amp service is available.
5. REFUNDS & CLASS CANCELLATIONS: In the case where a horse has been entered and not shown in a Dressage class, fees will be forfeited. Refunds will only be made with a vet certificate or if canceled prior to closing date minus \$30 office fee. Refunds will be made within 2 days after the show.
6. PAYMENTS: All payments are taken through StriderPro.com. Use a Credit card, VENMO or PayPal. <https://bit.ly/KDCTAEventRegistration>
8. ***All Competitors need to check out at the registration office before leaving the show grounds.***

Specific Rules for Dressage Shows

1. TESTS: Readers are permitted for all tests. USDF 2023 Intro through 4th level Dressage tests, USEA 2022 Eventing tests, WDAA 2022 Western Dressage tests, and USAWE 2024 Working Equitation tests will be used. (Links to TESTS can be found at KDCTA.org at the bottom of the horse shows page) No Horse/Rider combination may enter more than two consecutive dressage levels. Higher level tests or other types of dressage tests may be ridden upon request. All Dressage Classes must be pre-registered/pre-paid. Intro and possibly some Training level tests (or equivalent of) will be ridden in the Small arena. Some Training (depending on how many rides there are) MFS and First level tests and above will be ridden in the Large arena.
2. COPIES OF DRESSAGE TESTS are available upon request from the show secretary for \$1 per test or may be printed from the USDF, USEF/USEA, WDDA, and USAWE websites.
3. TOC—Any dressage Test of Choice may be ridden. Rider must let Show Secretary know which test of choice.

4. MUSICAL FREESTYLE & QUADRILLE: May ride test of choice or create your own. Any number of riders allowed. Music must be at the announcer's stand 1 hour prior to class in CD or USB format.
5. RIDE TIMES will be emailed and posted on the website 48 hours before the show.

6. All tests will be ridden in the appropriate large or small dressage arena. See #1.
7. Dressage entries received after the closing date will be charged a late fee (\$30) and will be considered only if spots are available. Contact the Show Secretary.

Awards

1. DRESSAGE: All dressage tests will be placed using the Danish System. 1st-6th place based on score.
2. FOXFIRE MEMORIAL TROPHY: Anyone of any age can sign up. Must be taking at least 2 dressage lessons a month. Ribbon awarded to highest average of 2 or more dressage tests. **Free**-Sign up - class #25.
